- Have you stated what you will try to achieve next?
- Have you looked at any other artists to support your ideas and explained how they have developed your work further?

## Week 6 – Experiments and development of ideas (AO2) and planning for AO4

- What technique/s did you use? Explain the process.
- Have you annotated your developments?
- Have you constructively stated your feelings about your work?
- Have you stated what you will try to achieve next?
- Have you looked at any other artists to support your ideas and explained how they have developed your work further?
- Have you annotated how you will create your final piece/s?
- Have you made a design/plan to support you with your final piece/s?
