## **Reading Intervention Waves**



The **Standard Age Score (SAS)** is the most important piece of information derived from NGRT. The SAS is based on the student's raw score which has been adjusted for age and placed on a scale that makes a comparison with a nationally representative sample of same age across the UK. The average score is 100. The SAS is key to benchmarking and tracking progress and is the fairest way to compare the performance of different students within a year group or across year groups.
